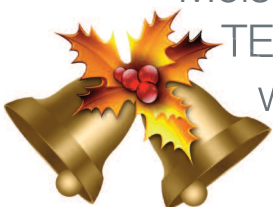

As 2010 draws to a close it is time to express our thanks to all those we do business with and to reflect on another year:

As Molson celebrated its 15th birthday in October we were pleased to be thankful for a relatively stable business, despite the generally troubled economy. Our sales volume held up against plan and the company is well positioned for further growth in 2011.

In 2010 we took on several new franchises: including **Kubota** (the worlds No.1 minidigger range) which has performed extremely well.

In the autumn **Keestrack** (Belgian based manufacturer of screens) merged with **OM** (Italian crushers) and we retain the UK rights to their combined ranges and expect their revamped models to perform very well in 2011.

Late in the year we signed up **IHI** for their Japanese made tracked dumpers which are ideal for wet sites and flood defences.

In conjunction with **Hyundai** we sponsored the worlds largest 'beach race' on the long wide sands at Weston-Super-Mare.

Now in its third year working with Hyundai, Molson has now become their biggest Hyundai dealer in Europe, and we expect our volume to grow significantly next year: The launch of their new 'Series 9' range early in 2010 has been very well received and this will be expanded to include mini and midi excavators early in 2011.

The UK construction industry was perhaps the first sector into recession in 2007, and recovered reasonably well (within the constraints of problems in the wider economy) in 2010 – perhaps with the exception of new housing. Most of our customers in civil engineering, groundworks, waste handling, and industrial and commercial building projects are readying themselves for more growth next year.

We thank our customers for their past support, and wish them and their families, best wishes for the holiday season and for a prosperous New Year.
